Various asana like , standing, sitting, **Vrikshasana**, **Bhujangasana**, suryanamaskar and **Pranayama** were practiced.

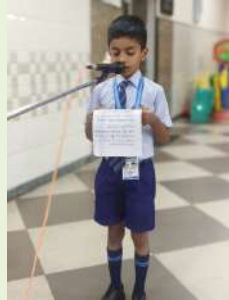

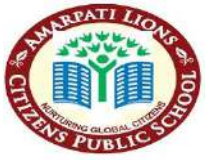

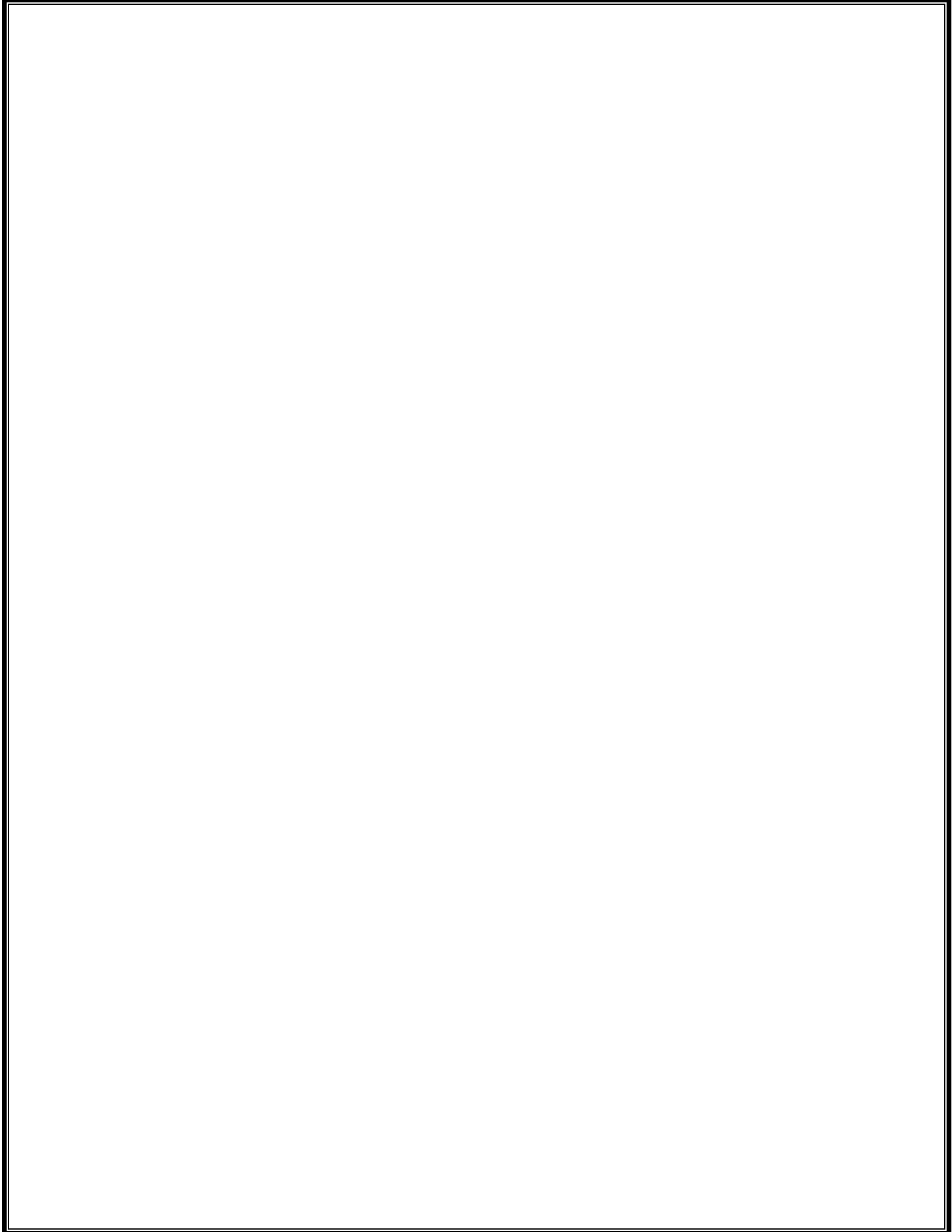
Science Department and witnessed the enthusiastic participation of students from all classes.
