### **Parents Orientation Program**

### ALCPS App

In line with the vision of embracing digital transformation in education, Amarpati Lions Citizens Public School proudly launched the **ALCPS App** during the academic session 2024–25. The ALCPS App has become a centralized digital platform for managing academic and administrative functions. Key features of the app include **generation of admit cards and report**
